CA PROPOSITION 65 STATEMENT & DECLARATION OF CONFORMITY

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 requires that the Governor of California revise and republish at least once per year the list of chemicals known to the State to cause cancer or reproductive toxicity. For easy reference, chemicals which are newly added are shown in underline. Chemicals or endpoints shown in strikeout were placed on the Proposition 65 list on the date noted, and have subsequently been removed.
